Investment objective: The Sub-Fund aims to achieve a long-term return in excess of MSCI All Country Asia Pacific ex Japan Index (Total Return Net) (the "Benchmark") by actively investing primarily in a portfolio of Asia Pacific companies (excluding Japan).

Investment policy: The Sub-Fund pursues an actively-managed investment strategy.

Investment approach

- Uses a fundamental, bottom-up stock selection process.
- Enhanced index approach that builds a portfolio in reference to the benchmark by overweighting securities with the highest potential to outperform and underweighting securities considered most overvalued.
- Diversified portfolio with disciplined, risk-controlled portfolio construction.
- Applies values and norms based screening and implements minimum investment thresholds on companies with positive ESG characteristics.

Investor profile: Typical investors in the Sub-Fund are expected to be investors who want to take broad market exposure to developed and emerging markets, who seek to benefit from potential excess returns with similar risks to investing in securities representing the Benchmark and who are prepared to accept the risks associated with an investment of this type, including the volatility of such market.



Key risks
