Objectives and investment policy

The fund is passively managed. The aim is for your investment to reflect the performance of the MSCI Europe Materials ESG Screened 20-35 Select Index (index). The index is based on the MSCI Europe Materials Index (Parent Index), which is designed to reflect the performance of shares in large and medium capitalisation companies across certain developed markets in Europe which are classified in the materials sector as per the Global Industry Classification Standard®. In order to be eligible for inclusion in the index, companies must be eligible for inclusion in the Parent Index and must meet certain ESG screening criteria. Securities which breach the following ESG standards, amongst others, are excluded: (i) are unrated by MSCI ESG Research, (ii) have any involvement in controversial weapons, (iii) breach certain revenue thresholds in controversial activities, including, but not limited to, civilian, conventional and nuclear weapons, tobacco, thermal coal, unconventional and/or arctic oil and gas extraction and palm oil, (iv) are assigned an MSCI ESG Rating of CCC and (v) are not in compliance with the United Nations Global Compact principles, have an MSCI Controversies Score of 0 or have an insufficient MSCI ESG Controversies Score related to certain biodiversity and/or environmental controversies. The index also includes a carbon emission reduction rule, whereby if having applied the above exclusions, the Greenhouse Gas (“GHG”) intensity of the index has been insufficiently reduced compared to the Parent Index, constituents are excluded by descending order of GHG intensity until a relevant reduction threshold is achieved. The weight of the largest group entity in the index is capped at 31.5%

and the weights of all other entities are capped at 18% at each quarterly index rebalancing. Where the largest group entity has exceeded 35% or any other entity has exceeded 20% in the lead up to each month-end, such entities will be rebalanced to 31.5% and 18% respectively. The index is calculated on a total return net basis which means that all dividends and distributions by the companies are reinvested in the shares after tax. The index is reviewed and rebalanced on at least a quarterly basis. The index is calculated in Euros on a daily basis. To achieve the aim, the fund will attempt to replicate the index, before fees and expenses, by buying all or a substantial number of the securities in the index. The fund may employ techniques and instruments in order to manage risk, reduce costs and improve results. These techniques and instruments may include the use of financial contracts (derivatives). The fund may also engage in secured lending of its investments to certain eligible third parties subject to certain ESG criteria to generate additional income to offset the costs of the fund. Transaction costs and taxes, unexpected fund costs and market conditions such as volatility or liquidity issues may affect the ability of the fund to track the index. The anticipated level of tracking error in normal market conditions is 1 per cent. The currency of the fund is EUR. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis.

Risk and reward profile



The calculation of the risk and reward profile is based on historical data that cannot be used as a reliable indicator for the future risk profile. This risk indicator is subject to changes; the classification of the fund may change over time and cannot be guaranteed. Even a fund that is classified in the lowest category (category 1) does not represent a completely risk-free investment. The fund is classified in category 6 because its share price may fluctuate strongly and the likelihood of both losses and gains may therefore be high. The following risks could be of particular significance for the fund: The fund will attempt to replicate the performance of the index less costs, but your investment is not expected to match the performance of the index precisely. Exceptional circumstances may arise, such as, but not limited to, disruptive market conditions, additional costs/taxes or extremely volatile markets, which may cause the fund's performance to be substantially different from the performance of the index. DWS entities and related companies may act in several roles in relation to the fund such as distributor and management company which may involve conflicts of interest. The value of an investment in shares will depend on a number of factors including, but not limited to, market and economic conditions, sector, geographical region and political events. The environmental, social and governance screening criteria are embedded within the index selection process, which seeks to exclude securities issued by companies involved in certain activities. The index is rules-based and is not capable of being adjusted to take into account changing market circumstances. The fund has a focus on a single or narrow range of industry, sector or types of companies and performance may not reflect a rise in broader markets. 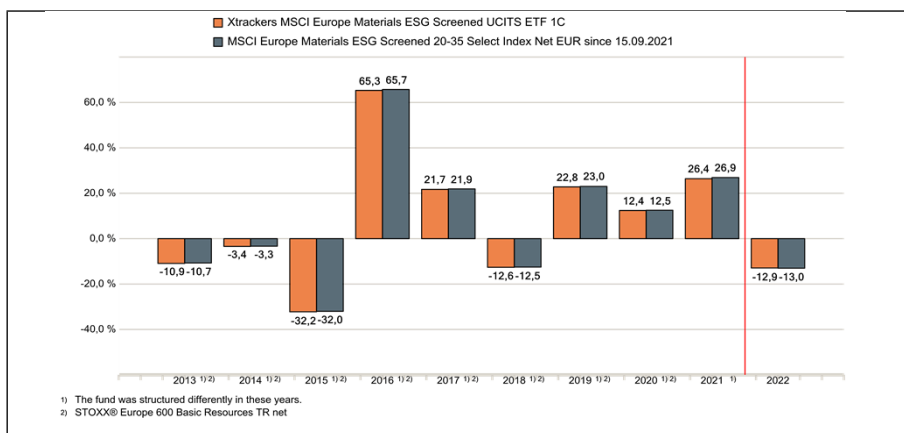

The ongoing charges figure is based on expenses for the fiscal year ending 31.12.2022. It may vary from year to year. It excludes portfolio transaction costs and performance fees, if any.

To the extent the fund undertakes securities lending to generate revenue, the fund will ultimately be allocated 70% of the associated revenue, the securities lending agent, which will be a DWS entity or other Deutsche Bank entity, will be allocated 15% and the remaining 15% will be allocated to the DWS entity which monitors such activities, as set out in the sales prospectus. As securities lending revenue sharing does not increase the costs of running the fund, this has been excluded from the composition of costs.

Past performance

All costs and fees that were withdrawn from the 1C share class of Xtrackers MSCI Europe Materials ESG Screened UCITS ETF were deducted during the calculation. The 1C share class of Xtrackers MSCI Europe Materials ESG Screened UCITS ETF was launched in 2007.

As of 15 September 2021 the fund changed its investment objective to reflect the performance of the index. The past performance shown from 2011 up to 2020 (inclusive), is that of the STOXX® Europe 600 Basic Resources Index. 2021 shows a combined performance of both indices.
